## DHS EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR TENNESSEE FLOOD VICTIMS

### Emergency Food Stamps (Apply by May 20)

- If you are NOT enrolled currently in the Food Stamp program
- If you reside in a county designated as a federal disaster area
- If you have unreimbursed expenses due to flood-related property damage
- If you have an adjusted net income below the Food Stamp income limit

### Replacement Food Stamps

- If you ARE enrolled currently in the Food Stamp program
- If you suffered food losses due to power outages of at least 12 hours
- If you report losses by May 21, replacement benefits can cover lost food and NOT current month's allocation

### Emergency Cash Assistance (Apply by May 20)

- Get one-time cash payments of \$250 (1-2 person household), \$500 (3 or more persons)
- If household income does not exceed 130% of federal poverty guidelines
- Household must be registered with FEMA
