The Bureau of Health Services Administration (HSA) is responsible for the delivery of public health services to the citizens and visitors of Tennessee, through a system of thirteen regional health offices. HSA is responsible for the oversight of services provided in eighty-nine rural and six metropolitan county health departments. These services encompass both primary care and prevention services with an emphasis on health promotion, disease prevention and health access activities.

Position Description:

Serve as Clinical Services and Disease Management Director and medical advisor to the HSA Assistant Commissioner. Assess, monitor and support rural regions and local health departments in building infrastructure and health service delivery systems involving primary care, nursing and employee health, dental and pharmacy services, and special populations programs, to include traumatic brain injury, hemophilia, and renal. Serve as advisor and supervisor to the State Nursing, Dental and Primary Care Directors and HSA Pharmacist. Work closely with the Division of Quality Improvement to establish and evaluate appropriate programs and patient outcome measures associated with cited programs. Serve as Emergency Services Coordinator for the Department of Health, Chairman of the Medical Services Evaluation Committee, and as a member of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee for Primary Care.

Qualifications:

Graduation from an approved school of medicine and eligible for licensure to practice medicine in the State of Tennessee.
